I hope you were encouraged by Brian Matuszak's article in last month's column. Brian and his family were also able to attend the Messianic Israel Alliance Conference in Nashville. We all enjoyed being with our brothers and sisters in Messiah.

During the conference, I heard more than one speaker talk about the struggles we all have with our flesh. In today's article, we will continue our teaching from May's newsletter on the "sark." For those of you new to our newsletter and as a refresher, let's briefly review the meaning of "sark."

2000-R). Ever since Adam and *Havah* ate of the Fruit of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, man has struggled with fleshly understanding. What often appears as good, is not! (For more information, please check out our Newsletter Archives for the May 2006 newsletter at setapartmingb.org.)

Throughout our lives, we have suffered traumas--the bad things that happened to us and the absence of the good things we needed in our lives. As a result, we have built up a reservoir of lies--"I'm no good; I'll never be good enough; how could God love me, I'm too dirty" and on and on. Our hearts have become sick. The prophets Isaiah, Jeremiah and Ezekiel addressed the issue of the sick hearts of the people of Israel, which caused them to fall into sin, away from *Elohim* and the teachings of His *Torah*, which eventually led to their dispersion.

Just as we need exercise and good food to produce healthy physical hearts, our spiritual hearts need attention as well. The true heart is the place of spiritual discernment. When our hearts are healthy, we are able to hear through the *Ruach HaKodesh* what is truly good and what is truly evil--we are living as *Elohim* created us.

- Find people who will speak into your life to counteract the "sark" and see the true worth of your heart.

Ephesians 2:8-10

*For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God--not by works, so that no one can boast. **FOR WE ARE GOD'S WORKMANSHIP, CREATED IN CHRIST JESUS TO DO GOOD WORKS, WHICH GOD PREPARED IN ADVANCE FOR US TO DO.** (NIV, emphasis by author)*

Because of the traumas we have experienced, it is often difficult to understand the true characteristics of our hearts. If this is true for you, begin to examine yourself by asking these questions:

But What About Grace?

Two months ago we were addressing the concerns that arise when we see so frequent messages of grace within Christian church circles. It became an issue for people newer to the Torah walk, wondering if grace is missing in the Messianic movement, since it isn't addressed as often. We spoke of historical misapplications of grace in our last edition and will move a little further through the list of possible questions today:

Is Grace the Opposite of Legalism? Is Grace Really Missing in the Old Testament? Can the Concept of Grace be Misapplied to Avoid Learning YHWH's Commands? How Do we Deal in Grace with People who don't trust God and His Grace because they have been Betrayed and Traumatized by Those who Should Have Protected Them? As One Moves toward Torah Obedience are there Precautions to follow to avoid falling into a Legalistic Snare?

Is Grace the opposite of Legalism? This concern isn't so hard to answer; if there were no standard that could be no expectation for behavior. If there is no expectation for behavior than every behavior would be equally right or wrong. In order for the concept of grace to exist at all, it stands to reason then that there must be a standard in order for a person to be given grace when they do not reach that standard. How grateful we all are that our Messiah was willing to drink the cup of affliction that is rightfully ours, granting us the grace that is so much a part of His character!

Legalism, as people tend to "throw around" the term today, is a concept that does not really exist in Scripture. (D. Thomas Lancaster has done an excellent exposition on this subject in his new book *Restoration: Returning the Torah of God to the Disciples of Jesus*.) People often use the words of Paul to justify any concern about keeping *Torah*, yet on closer study, it becomes apparent that this was NOT his intended message. At that time, Paul was concerned about the practice of teaching people that they couldn't come to faith in Messiah unless they went through the arduous process of conversion as defined by Judaism. It was insistence on this conversion process for people to become Messianic Believers in that day that Paul defined as "legalistic." He restated "Old Testament" teaching that He who

about?

- When have you taken a stand for something in which you strongly believed and did not back down? How did you feel about taking that stand?
- Looking through the eyes of *Yahshua*, how would you describe yourself?
- How do those closest to you see your heart? Ask them to describe you.

STUDENTS OF THE WORD

We are destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ and we are ready to punish all disobedience, whenever your obedience is complete. You are looking at things as they are outwardly. If anyone is confident in himself that he is Christ's, let him consider this again within himself, that just as he is Christ's, so also are we. (I Cor. 10:5-7 NASB)

Torah must be our measuring stick in all situations. By being serious students of the Word, we will understand what *Elohim* expects of us--how we are to live our lives. Not only must we be students of the Word, we must walk in HIS path of righteousness, always seeking His direction through prayer and at times fasting. By learning to understand the lies we have in our thinking, we will be better able to take those thoughts captive and allow *Yahshua* to show us the true way. (M.G.)

is a true Jew is one inwardly. True belief, is and always was a matter of circumcision of the heart! (Romans 2: 29) This picture is a message of obedience and submission to one's God. *Shema!* which means Hear AND obey, is the Hebrew command *YHWH* gave just before He gave what we have known as the ten commandments. *Shema* is a part of the prayer every observant Jewish person will recognize for they pray it daily. It means to love your God and to live out that love by hearing and obeying Him. Sound familiar?

Today, people tend to fear that any effort to obey commands is a form of rigidity, an absence of grace, a loss of liberty or freedom so any effort to observe *YHWH's Torah*/Righteous Teachings- usually defined as Law-- seems to them to be going counter to their understanding of grace and leeway, and freedom with Messiah. Yet in truth, those of us who are parents can perhaps better understand that our children have no less true "freedom" when they obey our teachings that are meant to keep them safe from harm. It is when they move outside the parameters we lay out for them that they can come into harm's way. Do we not experience our children's cheerful obedience to our direction as indicative of their love and respect for us? So it is with our Father, *YHWH*.

Another aspect of grace may be explored by examination of the concepts of "by the letter" and "by the spirit." *Yahshua* is said to have taught principles that seem often to be closer to the school of *Hillel*, one of the two leading Pharisee Rabbinical teachers of His day. The school of *Hillel* was known and respected for it's emphasis on teaching obedience to the spirit of the Law; that is comprehending the intent and heart purpose for instructions in order to lead people toward the desired behavior, thus pleasing *YHWH*. The opposing school was that of *Shammai*, who was known for teaching the need to meet the letter of the law, not necessarily allowing for circumstances. Out of concern for their responsibility to teach people how to obey, it seems that both schools of thought did eventually add what are called "fence laws". These additional rules were designed to prevent people from even getting close to breaking the commandments, but in fact added such stringent requirements that not even the teachers themselves could always keep them. These are two different ways of teaching obedience yet in 70 A.D. when the Temple was destroyed, these Pharisees and the Messianic Believers were the only surviving branches of Judaism. There WERE many Pharisees who did accept *Yahshua* as Messiah and many thousands of Jewish people who believed. All followers of *Yahshua* were of Jewish

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descent for at least the first fifteen years though this fact has often been lost to us. They kept the *Torah* and all the appointed times, while joyously recognizing Messiah had come! They saw no conflict or lack of grace in keeping the commands of the One they served.

Here is how we know we love God's children: when we love God we also do what He commands. For loving God means obeying His commands. 1 John 5: 2- 3 Complete Jewish Bible Translation
Everyone who keeps sinning is violating Torah— indeed, sin is violation of Torah. 1 John 3: 4 Complete Jewish Bible Translation

Interpreting God's Righteous Teachings/ *Torah* in such a way as to lead people toward the desired behavior would seem to me to be a form of grace. This is far different than simply imposing a set of requirements on people with no concern for the impact on them. THIS is what *Yahshua* was holding the Jews accountable for doing! Adding unnecessary burdens to His own Righteous Teachings/*Torah* that added to the stress of people rather than benefiting them. It was NOT the Law/Righteous Teaching itself that He opposed! The Pharisees were scrupulous in their efforts to obey YHWH and keep His commands, no matter which school they followed. If the Righteous Teachings themselves were in question doesn't it seem that they would not have been permitted to survive, when all other branches of Judaism were destroyed?

If one doesn't have a set of expectations by which to live; or in the case of parents a set of guidelines for expected behavior of their children, there would be no sort of boundary for appropriate and inappropriate behavior. If there were no boundaries for appropriate and inappropriate behavior, there would be no need for *chesed*/grace because there would be no way to DEFINE grace. (If I never say "no," just what is my "yes" worth?)

It was the added burdens that *Yahshua* spoke out against. He also affirmed repeatedly that "If you Love me, you will obey my commands." Which commands are *Yahshua's* commands? Well, it is said that there are (only) 613 commandments in the Old Testament and (over) 1050 in the New Testament. Every one of the 1050 has it's root in the 613; and even more specifically in the 10. And when we understand that *Yahshua* said that ALL the Law could be summarized in two and that *Yahshua* was THERE at Mount Sinai when the Law tablets were given to Moses, we get a clearer picture of which commands we are to obey OUT OF LOVE FOR HIM. (NOTE: A summary may come before or after a larger report but the summary itself has never yet replaced or done away with the main body of the report it restates in

brief form.) As Paul said to Timothy: *ALL Scripture is God breathed and is valuable for teaching the truth, convicting of sin, correcting faults and training of right living thus anyone who belongs to God may be fully equipped for every good work.* 2 Timothy 3: 16- 17 Complete Jewish Bible Translation What existed of Scripture when this letter was written? Why what we call the Old Testament of course! From Genesis to Malachi: the Law, the Prophets and the Writings! Do you recall how we can know that *Yahshua* really IS our Messiah? That He fulfilled the prophecies spoken about Him, particularly in Isaiah, but also pictured in every aspect of Old Testament teachings. IF He had deviated even one small jot or tittle from anything that *YHWH* directed, HE would not be our Messiah! Check out John 17, in which He confirmed that He and the Father are One, and that He did nothing unless it was of the Father. Recall the words He spoke on the road to Emmaus, when he spoke to the disciples of the Law and the Prophets and how it was written that the Messiah must suffer and die, for all the Law and the Prophets was written about Him.
