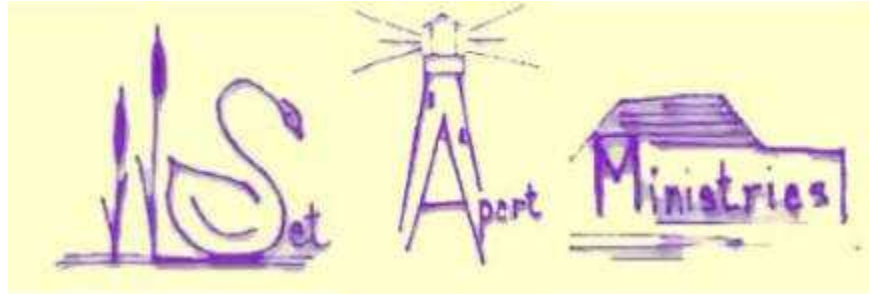


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## Conquering Life's Mountains Together!

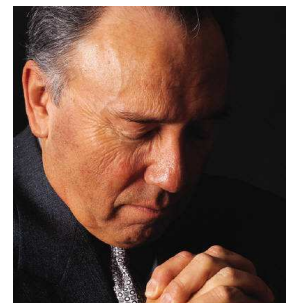

### *Maturing in Prayer*

Have you ever thought about how your prayer life changes as you begin to draw closer to your Heavenly Father? Maybe you haven't noticed any change or haven't even thought about it. Maybe you are longing for a deeper prayer life!

*Life Model: Living from the Heart Jesus Gave You* (copyright 2000 by The Shepherd's House), defines five levels of maturity. Physical aging doesn't guarantee maturity. The five different



maturity levels in the *Life Model* are: **the Infant Stage, the Child Stage, the Adult Stage, the Parent Stage and the Elder Stage.** The look or sound of our prayer life is influenced by our maturity level. Here are our initial thoughts about each of these stages. Again, we'd love to hear from you--what do you think about maturity in prayer? Where do you see yourself? What do you remember about being a new believer?, etc.

1. **The New Believer.** Prayers tend to be "me" centered, probably joyful and excited. Aware of the blessings Jesus (*Yahshua*) has given them. Prayers are generally focused on asking for blessings for their own decisions--"help me to...." kind of prayers. The New Believer is usually unaware of "the cost" and expectations of coming into the Kingdom. May perceive God as brother or friend most easily.

2. **Becoming More Serious about Faith.** Beginning to be aware that there are expectations for being in the Kingdom, including discipline and "pruning". Struggling to be humble yet still expecting one's own expectations to be met. Often easily discouraged. Unbelief and doubt quickly come in. May perceive Father and Son as Lord and a beginning awareness of the Spirit working in their life.

3. **Becoming a Servant of God.** Developing an awareness of the goals of humility, that one's own expectations may not be the goal. Occasionally able to trust without understanding. Beginning to understand that it is God's plan that is important, not our own ideas. May still be easily discouraged at times. Beginning to perceive Father, Son and Spirit as King and Lord but perhaps in a more abstract sense.

4. **Becoming a Bond Servant of God.** Most often aware of God's plan as of paramount importance. Increasing sense of intimacy with Him. Most often able to release one's own expectations in favor of whatever unknown plan God has without **daily** questioning. Struggling, developing humility. Looking beyond man's traditions and perceptions to **God's** directions and ways of serving and worshiping Him as He defines it. Perceiving Father, Son and Spirit as King and Personal Master over one's life.

5. **Becoming the Betrothed Wife.** Humility, personal expectations are submitted to God's plan. Most often unquestioning trust in His goodness and plan. Confident to approach the Throne of Grace boldly with expectations of results. An affectionate, confident presumptuousness, yet within the bounds of the intimacy of the relationship while still acknowledging Him as King, yet standing with Him as a purified, set apart Bride, as Wife, sharing the Throne? and purpose.

Well, what do you think? We pray this is as exciting for you to explore as it is for us!
